SENIOR PRACTICUM

DESCRIPTION OF SENIOR PRACTICUM FOR ADULT PARTNERS

1. Preparation for Senior Practicum placement

- Senior Practicum is a class required of all junior students at Power House High
- Students develop resumes and portfolios of their work, participate in mock interviews
- Identify the career in which they would like to work
- Connect with an Adult Partner in that career area
- Students attend individual conferences with timelines, objectives and goals for Senior Practicum
- Senior Practicum activities take place during the student's junior/senior year at Power House High

2. Selection of Adult Partners

- Students contact potential Adult Partners, who complete a Personal Data Sheet
- Practicum Coordinator contacts those potential Adult Partners to discuss responsibilities and review agreement form
- Based on an interview and the Personal Data Sheet, Practicum Coordinator approves student's Adult Partner choices

3. Orientation Process

Adult Partner Orientation

- Meetings to be held on a rolling basis with first meeting to occur before student begins their Practicum experience
- Review forms, documentation guidelines, timelines, goals, objectives and evaluation procedures
- Review roles, responsibility and work schedule for Adult Partner and student
- Review emergency policies and procedures
- Clarify any issues and answer any questions

Students and parents also attend formal orientation sessions
